Characteristics

Genus & Species: Physocarpus opulifolius Protection Status: PP18,660; COPF Open.

USDA Zone: USDA Zone 2. (-50°F or -46°C).

Bloom: Clusters of charming pink blushed blooms.

Bloom Time: Spring-early summer.

Foliage: Deciduous, glossy coral to red toned foliage. **Habit:** Tightly branched rounded habit. 6' x 4'.

Propagation: Tip Cuttings / Semi-hardwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Best grown in full sun to part shade in fertile well drained soils.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established. Attracts hummingbirds. Deer resistant.
