Bloom:	Foliage selection.
Bloom Time:	N/A.
Foliage:	Evergreen aromatic, bright yellow-gold foliage, year round.
Habit:	Tight upright pyramidal habit becoming conical with maturity. 8' x 4' in 10 years. (Ultimately 20' x 5' untrimmed).
Propagation:	Mature winter cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best grown in full sun in moist well drained soils.
Additional Comments:	Dislikes dry conditions – this may lead to foliage burn. Color holds well in winter temperatures. Sport from industry mainstay, T. Emerald Green ('Smaragd').
Uses:	Container Specimens, Garden Specimen, Landscape Plantings. Hedging.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon:	3 months from a 2.5" liner (Spring Planting).
2 Gallon:	12 months from a 2.5" liner (Spring Planting).
