Key Features

Characteristics

Genus & Species:Abelia grandiflora x chinensisProtection Status:US Plant Patent 15,203.USDA Zone:Zone 6. (-10°F or -23°C).

Bloom: Pink buds opening to pure white tubular flowers.

Bloom Time: Summer-Fall.

Foliage: Elegant variegated foliage. Green with white margins with new growths flushed pink. Held on pink

to red stems.

Habit: Compact mounding habit. 2.5' x 5'.

Propagation: Softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.* **Culture:** Best grown in part shade for full foliage effect.

Additional Comments: Heat & drought tolerant once established. No photo-bleaching in southern Georgia testing.

Uses: Pots & containers, garden border, foundation or mass landscape plantings.
